### A Message from CMF President

Happy  $2^{nd}$  Anniversary to the Carrie Mehdi Foundation. In the last two years, we have increased our donations to other non-profits thanks to all of our supporters.

This summer was a sad time for all of us as we lost Carrie and Zafar's son Greg (a Founding Director of CMF) in a tragic car accident in July. Over the last year, Greg passionately led the Carrie Mehdi Foundation Board to expand our supported charities to organizations that support marginalized individuals based in Pasadena and Los Angeles. Like his mother, Greg's passion for giving back and helping others will live on through our Foundation. We will miss Greg's enthusiasm and joie de vivre at our annual picnic and other events, but his legacy will live on as we raise money to donate in Greg and Carrie's names. In this issue, we have highlighted three donations made in Greg's memory, totaling \$3,000. Thank you to all who sent in donations to honor Greg. Your funds are already giving back to organizations he himself led us to.

I would also like to thank the donors who sent in donations in memory of my dog Francis this summer (Ch Schoolhouse Francis Rocks CGC THD). These donations resulted in a \$1,000 donation to the American Kennel Club Canine Health Foundation, which funds research that helps dogs live longer and healthier lives. On September 14, 2014, some of us traveled to the Monterey/Carmel area to honor Greg and Carrie in Point Lobos State Nature Preserve.
