

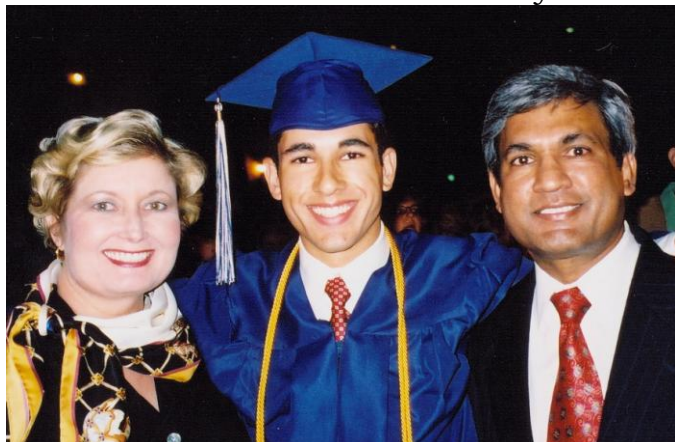
**FAREWELL TO MY SON

Dear family and friends,

I am heartbroken to communicate this sad and devastating news to you. My beloved son Greg was involved in a car accident and passed away last week. Greg just recently celebrated his 30th birthday. Greg's mother and my wife, Carrie, had sadly passed away about 2 years ago unexpectedly from a stroke.

Greg was born at Huntington Hospital in Pasadena, California in July 1984. His early education, from Pre-Kindergarten to 6th grade, was at Clairbourn School, a private school near Pasadena. Then in 7th grade he was admitted to Flintridge Preparatory School, a private school in La Canada Flintridge, and completed his high school with honors from Flintridge Prep in 2003. After that he was admitted to Tufts University in Massachusetts where he earned his Bachelor of Arts degree with a double major in Environmental Science and American Studies. Then Greg came back to Los Angeles and became interested in real estate and started his own real estate consulting company. He was very successful in his business and lived happily with his girlfriend Elizabeth in Los Angeles.

Greg loved life and enjoyed reading, golf, music, and attending concerts. After his mom's passing, with family and friends, he led the formation of the "Carrie Mehdi Foundation" (CMF), a non-profit 501c3 charitable organization, to continue to support the kind of organizations that his mom supported. Greg was a member of the Board of Directors of CMF. Greg was passionate about supporting organizations that helped people who needed help. With his recommendation, CMF added Homeless Health Care Los Angeles, the Midnight Mission, Union Station Homeless services and Los Angeles Mission to the list of organizations that CMF supports.
